Member, Board of Directors: Must be a voter of the District, or as otherwise specified in the Principal Act of the District. Monterey Peninsula Airport Candidates must be a registered voters in the district for at least 30 days immediately preceding the deadline for filing nomination documents.

In addition to other nomination requirements, candidates for the Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District and the Moss Landing Harbor District must collect nomination signatures.

Candidates seeking information about city offices and for city measures, please contact the appropriate City Clerk for specific requirements and deadlines.

Declarations of candidacy and other required nomination documents for eligible candidates desiring to run for any of the elective offices may be obtained and filed at the office of the Registrar of Voters located at 1370 B South Main Street, Salinas, CA, on or after Monday, July 18, 2016 and must be filed at the same location not later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 12, 2016. If an eligible incumbent does not file a declaration of candidacy by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 12, 2016, any eligible person other than the incumbent shall have until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 17, 2016 to file a declaration of candidacy for the elective office. Interested candidates may also call (831) 796-1499 for more information.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that the last day to submit primary arguments in favor of or against any Measures submitted to the Monterey County Elections Department is Thursday, August 18, 2016 by 5:00 p.m. Arguments are limited to 300 words and may be signed by up to five persons.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the last day to submit rebuttal arguments in response to arguments in favor of or against any Measures submitted to the Monterey County Elections Department is Thursday, August 25, 2016 by 5:00 p.m. Rebuttal arguments are limited to 250 words.
